ATTEMPTED TO GUT a stronger ban on Partial Birth Abortion. It became law through the action of the General Assembly.

ATTEMPTED TO GUT the Parental Consent law. It became law through the action of the General Assembly.

ATTEMPTED TO WEAKEN the Unborn Victims of Violence Act. His amendment failed by large margins before he signed the act into law.

U.S. House of Representatives RACES & Recommendations

- **1st District:** Congressman Rob Wittman is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC. He had a 100% pro-life voting record as a member of the Virginia legislature.
- **2nd District:** Cong. Thelma Drake is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC. She has a 100% pro-life voting record. Her opponent, Glenn Nye III, is endorsed by the political arm of nation's largest abortion provider, Planned Parenthood.
- **4th District:** Cong. Randy Forbes is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC and has a 100% pro-life voting record. His opponent is pro-abortion.
- **5th District:** Cong. Virgil Goode is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC. His pro-life voting record is 100%.
- **6th District:** Cong. Bob Goodlatte is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC.
- **7th District:** Cong. Eric Cantor has voted pro-life 100% of the time and is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC.
- **8th District:** Mark Ellmore is challenging pro-abortion Cong. Jim Moran, who has voted against the pro-life position 78 out of 85 times, including in favor of taxpayer-funded abortions. Ellmore has a pro-life position and is recommended for election by Virginia Society for Human Life.
- **10th District:** Cong Frank Wolf is endorsed by Virginia Society for Human Life PAC and National Right to Life PAC. His opponent, Judy Feder, received the endorsement of EMILY's List, a group who only endorses Democratic women who support unrestricted, tax-payer funded abortion on demand.
- **11th District:** Keith Fimian has a pro-life position and is recommended for election by Virginia Society for Human Life. His opponent, Gerry Connolly, is pro-abortion and endorsed by leading pro-abortion PACs, including NARAL's (National Abortion Rights Action League) and the political arm of the nation's largest abortion provider, Planned Parenthood.
