What is BRAC?

The Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) is a process implemented by DoD to reorganize its base structures to improve efficiency and effectiveness in supporting its forces, to increase operational readiness, and to facilitate new ways of doing business. As a result, many workers impacted by BRAC face job shifts, career changes, layoffs and relocations.

Free Employment Services Help You Build Your Future

There are many options available to you if your job is jeopardized by BRAC initiatives or you're interested in being a part of a skilled workforce needed for BRAC expansions. You and your family can get free

job services, provided to uniformed people and certain civilians, spouses, dependent children (over 18) and dependent parents, at **no cost**. The **SkillSource** One-Stop Centers provide free:

- ★ Skill assessment and career interests tests
- ★ Job counseling and career coaching
- ★ Resume preparation
- ★ Access to Northern Virginia labor market information (LMIS)
- ★ Funding for new skills training (if you are eligible)
- ★ Referrals to employers who are hiring new workers

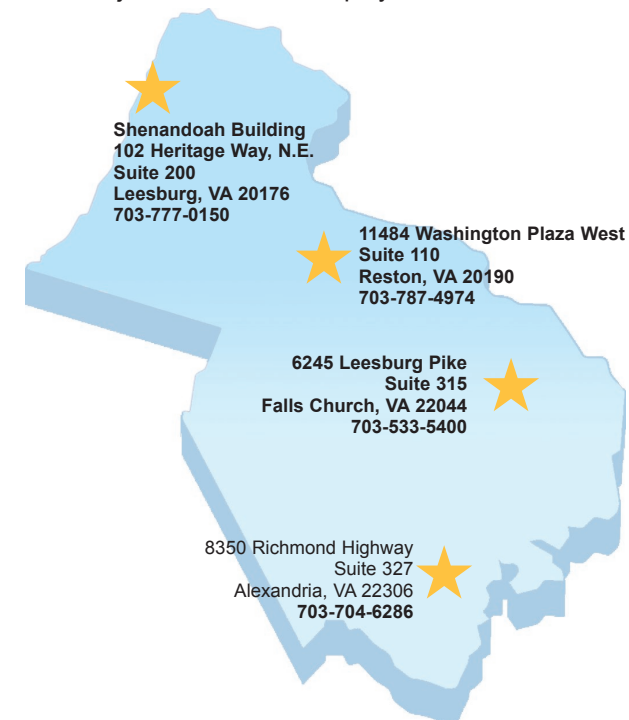
