I still cannot believe that another year has already gone by. Christmas is upon us and a new year is almost here. As my family and I look back, we thank the Lord for all He has done.

At the end of October I travelled to Naval Brig Miramar, ~~San Diego, California~~. We were blessed to see 8 saved in 7 services! I am tentatively planning to return to the brig at the end of January, so please continue to keep these incarcerated servicemen and women in your prayers.

In November, I met a team of seven preachers at ~~Fort Leavenworth, Kansas~~ for our fall revival services at the US Disciplinary Barracks and Regional Corrections Facility. We started off the week with 2 saved during the incredible "kick off" concerts and services with the ~~Redman~~ family. We conducted a total of 11 services and had 8 professions of faith. Countless others made life changing decisions for Christ during the week!

In the final and closing service, the chaplain asked if there were any testimonies. One young marine stood up and began to tell his story. "I first met Brother Lance several years ago while incarcerated at the Miramar Brig. I had planned to take my own life one night but a friend invited me to attend a Rock of Ages service in the chapel. I told God that if I didn't get some real help, I was going to end my life... Well, I got the help I needed and I am standing here today." All the men in the chapel were fixed upon his words, "I got saved that night and the Lord literally gave me life! Thank the Lord for the Rock of Ages. Thank you for reaching lives like mine with the Gospel!" I was reminded of the urgency of the mission! There are so many to reach, some of whom are literally at death's door. You CAN make a difference & lives are hanging in the balance!

In my last letter I mentioned the potential ministry opportunities at the new naval brig in Chesapeake, Virginia. Even now, as I am typing this letter, we have a Rock of Ages missionary chaplain serving within this new brig! Although this is a temporary "assignment", it looks like the Lord is holding the door wide open for ministry within this facility. Please continue to pray for the new missionary who will tentatively relocate here (*he is still working to raise his financial support*) as well as for continued favor with the Naval officials.

- Pray for tentative revival services at the ~~Fort Leavenworth~~ JRCF & USDB in the spring of 2012
- Pray for the new ministry opprtunities & tentatively scheduled revival services at the Naval Consolidated Brig ~~Chesapeake~~ in the spring of 2012
- We are still in need of a good commentary set and Webster's 1828 dictionary for the ROA College of Biblical Studies students I have at the Fort Lewis prison.

Although we only anticipated having one daughter with braces, both of the girls now have them. I told the girls that all they get for Christmas this year is a mouth full of metal! Although we can't really afford to, my family and I apparently just took the orthodontist on for monthly financial support by faith. ☺ Other than that, we are all happy, healthy and doing well. God has been so gracious!

We are eternally indebted to God for His amazing gift of salvation. Remember Jesus this CHRISTmas and the price He paid! Also, please take a moment to remember all our military men and women who cannot be at home with their families this Christmas. Please keep them in your prayers! My family and I thank you for another year of faithful prayers & financial support as we serve the Lord on the mission field of America's military prisons & installations. We praise the Lord for each one of you!
