

SUPPORT MINISTRIES MAJOR - 128 HOURS

The Support Ministries major offers students who are not necessarily called into Pastoral, Missionary or Youth Ministry the opportunity to be useful to the local church in a supporting role. This major includes courses with instruction in computer hardware, applications and information management. Skills will be developed in publishing, church sound systems and recording, presentations, photography and accounting. Students will be taught principles and concepts vital to church administration, construction and law. While the curriculum focuses on these practical skills, it will be emphasized that they are minimal without a consistent walk with God, faithfulness in soulwinning and loyalty to the pastor. Students in this major will also study through every book of the Bible.
