Join us for our 3rd Annual "WALK FOR LIFE" on May 14, 2011 at the Montgomery Zoo.

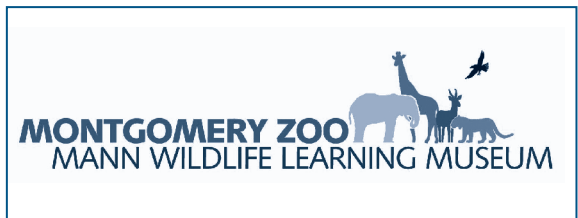

ALABAMA STATE SENATE RECOGNIZES PREGNANCY CENTERS



Directors from Crisis Pregnancy Centers all over the State of Alabama were present March 31, 2011 as the Alabama Legislature praised the work of pregnancy centers. The Alabama Senate passed a Resolution to *Recognize the Contributions of Pregnancy Care Centers and Encourage Congress to Grant Pregnancy Care Centers Assistance for Medical Equipment and Abstinence Education*. The Resolution, HJR16, commends the non-profit organizations throughout the state for their tremendous service to women, children, and the community passed the Alabama House in early March.

Fifty plus non-profit, primarily volunteer staff crisis pregnancy centers in the state of Alabama provide free, confidential and compassionate services including pregnancy tests, counseling, childbirth and parenting classes, free ultrasounds, and referrals to community, health care, and other support services.

Over thirty Directors from Crisis Pregnancy centers around the state of Alabama were present March 31st in Montgomery at the State House for the passing of Resolution HJR16 introduced by Representatives Blaine Galliher and Mike Hill. Senator Scott Beason and others were also supportive of this Resolution.

The Resolution states that the Legislature of Alabama recognize the many contributions made by pregnancy care centers and that they strongly support pregnancy care centers in their unique, positive contributions to the individual lives of women, men, and babies, both born and unborn. Last year, over 45,000 women were helped through crisis pregnancy centers in the state of Alabama.

ALABAMA LEGISLATION

Over the last few months there have been many bills brought before the Alabama Legislature concerning LIFE. Pro-choice individuals have made their opinions known. Unfortunately, the opinions from pro-life individuals have not been heard from as much. Have you expressed your views? Call your representative and let them know. Google ‘Alabama Legislature,’ find your representative and voice your opinion.

1. Healthcare Conscience Bill
SB46 (Senator Cam Ward) – Favorable public hearing on March 30 and should be on Senate Health Committee calendar for vote April 13, 2011. There is much opposition from hospital, medical, trial lawyer, retail and other groups. We are trying to develop an acceptable substitute.
HB178 (Rep. Mary Sue McClurkin) – Carried over in House Health Committee March 23, 2011. Waiting on the Senate bill.
2. Umbilical Cord Blood Storage Information Act
SB45 (Senator Cam Ward) – Passed out of Senate Health Committee March 23, 2011. Awaiting placement on a special order calendar for consideration by the Senate. HB138 (Rep. Mary Sue McClurkin) – No action. Waiting on Senate bill.
3. Opt Out of Federal Abortion Insurance Exchange
SB183 (Senator Greg Reed) – Passed out of Senate Health Committee March 23, 2011, but is a deficient bill.
SB202 – A better version passed out of the Senate Health Committee on April 6, 2011 and awaits inclusion on special order calendar for Senate consideration.
4. Abortion Coverage Prohibition Act
SB201 – Prohibits elective abortion coverage without special rider. Passed out of Senate Health Committee March 23, 2011. Awaiting placement on a special order calendar for consideration by the Senate.
5. Fetal Pain Bill
SB___ – No action.
HB18 (Representative Rich) – Voted out of House Health Committee April 6, 2011 and awaiting inclusion in the special order calendar for the House.
6. Crisis Pregnancy Centers Recognition Resolution
HJR16 (Representative Blaine Galliher) – Passed House and Senate Recognition of CPC’s given on March 31, 2011.
7. Abortion Inducing Drug Safety Act
SB298 – Voted favorably out of Senate Health Committee April 6, 2011

Awaiting placement on the special order calendar for Senate consideration.
HB___ - No action.

8. Statutory Personhood Bill

SB301 (Senator Phil Williams) – Voted favorably out of the Senate Health Committee April 6, 2011 and awaits inclusion on the special order calendar for Senate consideration.

Comment: This is an amendment to the Alabama Code which would provide a statutory definition that persons include all humans from moment of fertilization. It is one of two bills related to personhood (the other being a not yet filed proposed constitutional amendment), being sponsored by a personhood group. Sponsored by a local personhood group.

9. Right to Know and See

SB308 (Senator Scofield) – Voted favorably out of the Senate Health Committee on April 6, 2011 and awaits inclusion on the special order calendar for consideration by the Senate. Comment: This is a National Right to Life Committee written and sponsored bill.

The Sav-A-Life Board of Directors along with the Staff would like to thank the **Kiwanis Club of Montgomery** for making our renovation possible.
