Activity is : A Year 1 visit to the Priory Church, Pamber End, as part of their R.E. topic on special places.
The risk assessment should be shared with all adults assisting on the trip.

Danger from passing traffic on main road as children walk along the road from school to the drive leading to the Priory Church	Risk of injury	Medium	Children instructed as to how to behave before leaving school grounds. Pupils to remain in their pairs and are escorted to the church by supervisory adults. Adults to walk at the front, middle and back. Children to walk on grass verge where possible, off of the road. Children to stand still when cars are passing. Children must walk.	Low
Danger from passing cars or farm vehicles on the drive leading to the church. Also, it has an uneven surface, so the children may fall.	Risk of injury	Low	Children to follow the same procedure as above.	Low
Accident from falling	Risk of injury	Low	First aid kits to be carried by adults	Low
Danger from the heavy church door catching fingers, hitting heads etc.	Risk of injury	Low	Adult to hold door whilst children enter the church and then secure it as well as holding it whilst the children leave at the end of the visit.	Low
Danger from children pulling things down on themselves or falling such as hymn books, lecturn or candlesticks.	Risk of injury	Medium	Children instructed not to climb on anything. Children not allowed to touch anything unless instructed to.	Low
Members of the public	Interfering	Low	Pupils to remain in their groups supervised by their adults. They are to be made aware that they follow the instructions given and stay with their group and adult leader.	Low
Pupils requiring the toilet	Pupils requiring the toilet	Low	Pupils to be toileted before leaving school and made aware that they will not be able to go to the toilet again until return to school. Max time away from school 1 hour.	Low
