**E**ach week brings new clients and new opportunities for counselors and nurses. This particular morning was no exception when we met with a bright young woman who was close to completion of a college degree and excited about her promising future. After taking two home pregnancy tests, she came

to First Choice to have her pregnancy confirmed. Having a baby was definitely not in the plans of this college student. Although she knew abortion was wrong, she commented that she had always said that she would have an abortion if she became pregnant while in college. Needless to say, she was very abortion minded. This precious girl had not told her parents that she may be pregnant although she has a very close knit and supportive family. She had sought the counsel of her sisters, close friends (including one who had an abortion) However, the plans for her career, uncertainty of her future with the father of her baby, and the fear of disappointing her parents were key factors in her leaning heavily to aborting her child. We knew she was struggling with her decision as she became emotional as we prayed and talked during her 2 ½ hour visit. She was not only open to sharing about her circumstances and feelings but was also open to listening to the facts presented to her.
