

THEOLOGY MAJOR - 128 HOURS
MISSIONARY MINISTRY

Every missions student will be instructed in every book of the Bible. This book-by-book approach will give the student a mastery of the Word of God. The student will also develop basic skills in Biblical language. In this course we will be preparing men and women for their calling to the foreign mission field. Along with this thorough teaching of the Bible, the student will be required to learn about other world religions and expose himself to cultures, manners and customs that could challenge his/her effectiveness. These students will be encouraged to take a trip to a foreign mission field and assist a veteran missionary during the summer preceding their senior year. Missions students will also take practical courses that will enhance their ability to have a more effective deputation and more durability on the field. Furthermore, they will be taught to build relationships between their sending church, other supporting churches, the missionary clearinghouse (if used) and the local churches that they plant on the foreign field. Ladies should replace homiletics with Lady's Ministry I & II.
