“Right now in Alabama, there are approximately 5,700 children in the foster care system. 60 – 75% of these children either already are, or will be available for Adoption. Most of the children that are available for Adoption are over the age of 10, and I think it is generally wise counsel to only adopt a child that is younger than your youngest child in the home.

However, here is another factoid to blow your mind. In the county I live in, Montgomery County, Alabama, there are currently more infants than there are homes to put them in. So, if a family is willing to take the foster-to-adopt track, they are very likely to be placed with an

We have been chosen to receive grant money to purchase the program Earn While You Learn. This curriculum covers many topics that our patients are lacking:

Parenting

Child care

Once established as a patient the mother and father will be offered classes. As they complete homework, attend classes, arrive on time, bring the father, etc., they will earn “Mommy Money” that can ‘purchase’ the items in our Baby Boutique.

A Sunday school class could pool funds to purchase a new car seat, stroller or baby furniture. There is no need to wrap anything!

infant whose parents will have their parental rights terminated because of abuse, neglect, or abandonment, thus creating the need for the infant to have a forever family.”

“According to the Department of Human Resources, there are approximately 5,700 children in foster care in Alabama.[1] 30% of these children are under the age of six, 32% are between the ages of seven and thirteen, and 38% are over the age of fourteen.

Children are placed into foster care as a result of such circumstances as physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, and abandonment. The state’s primary objective is to reunite the children with their biological parents. However, when these efforts fail, the state will initiate a process called Termination of Parental Rights (TPR). 60 to 75% of the children in foster care have gone or will go through the TPR process, thereby becoming eligible for adoption.

550 children were adopted from foster care in 2010 and approximately 570 children are currently available for adoption from the Alabama state foster care system.”

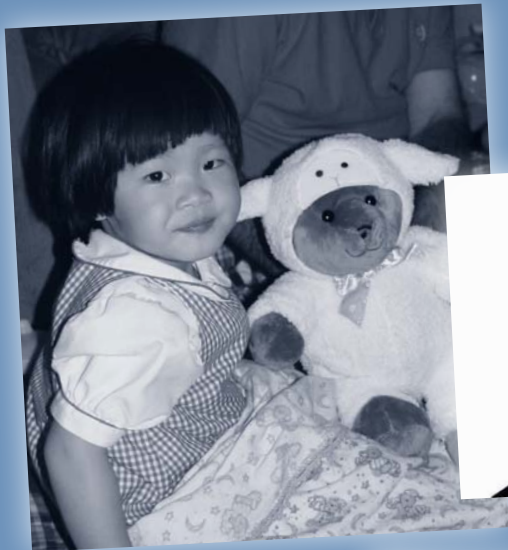

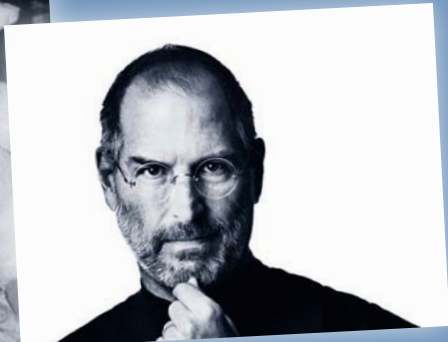
Goals of National Adoption Day

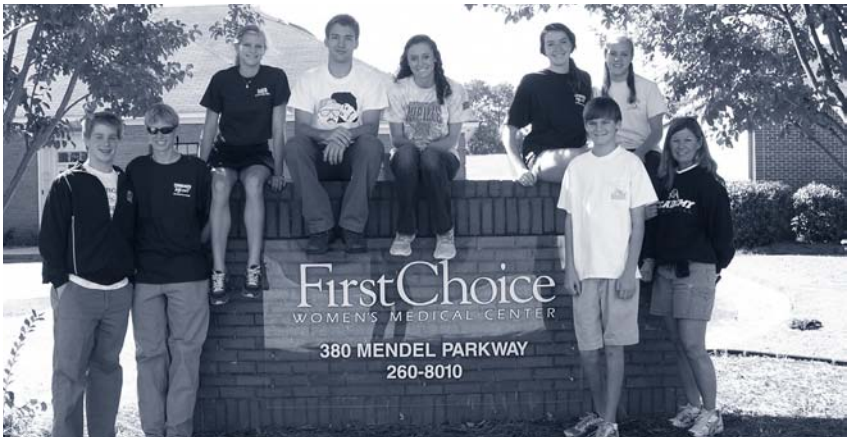

The Alabama Pro-Life Coalition Education Fund distributed funds from “Support Adoption/Choose Life” license tags.

During the period of July 1, 2010 to July 1, 2011, Alabama citizens purchased 6537 tags. Of the \$50 for each tag purchased, APLCEF receives \$41.25 bringing the total received to \$266,644.77 for the fiscal year. The Alabama Pro-Life Coalition Education Fund distributed the total amount of \$266,644.77 at a brief ceremony September 23, 2011. Sav-A-Life of Montgomery received \$4523.08.
