

E-commerce Integration with E-junkie

Your website allows for seamless integration with most of the popular e-commerce tools. As a turnkey solution, we recommend [E-junkie](#). It's very easy to integrate with your site and would allow you to:

- add a shopping cart or buy now buttons for tangible goods or digital products
- accept payments through a variety of payment processors ([PayPal](#), [Google Checkout](#), [Authorize.Net](#), [2Checkout](#), etc.)
- manage inventory, have sales tax, VAT, packaging and shipping costs automatically calculated
- define variants of tangible products such as size and color; use discounts and package deals
- choose between multiple currencies and languages and more.

E-junkie has a small [monthly subscription fee](#) based on the number of products. There is no transaction fee other than the standard fee of your selected payment processor.

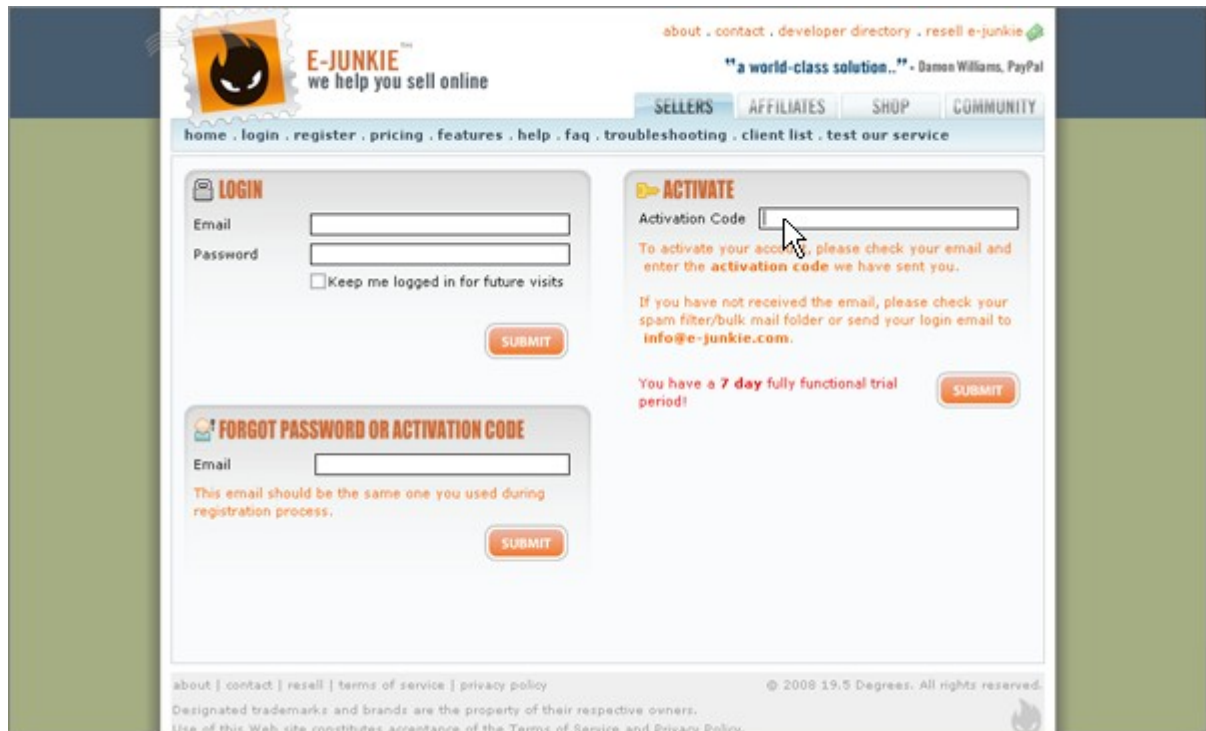
In this tutorial you'll learn how to make E-junkie work for your business.

E-junkie: Register an account

E-junkie: Configure your payment processors

You may set up different payment processors depending on how you wish to accept payments from customers and shape your billing process. To take a decision which processor to use, we'd recommend the following:

1. Note that E-junkie supports:

- Both Buy Now buttons and Shopping Carts with [PayPal](#), [Google Checkout](#), [Authorize.Net](#).
If you plan on selling tangible items you should consider using one of these processors to be able to benefit from the shipping, handling and tax calculator integrated with the shopping cart buttons. We'll review the setup of these processors in more detail.
- Only Buy Now buttons for [2CheckOut](#) and [TrialPay](#).

2. Review the [demo pages for the different processors](#) on E-junkie

3. Check the processing fees and per transaction fee for the processors you selected.

E-junkie: Shopping cart or Buy Now buttons through PayPal

Integration with [PayPal](#) Buy Now buttons or Shopping cart will enable your customers to pay via their PayPal account or the Credit card associated with it. You will receive payments into

your PayPal account. There is no setup or monthly fee for accepting payments through PayPal, the processing fee is ~3% + \$0.30 per transaction.

1. [Sign up](#) for a PayPal Premier or PayPal Business account

2. Within your E-junkie account go to Seller Admin > Edit Profile > Selling with PayPal and enter the email address associated with the PayPal account where you will accept payments.

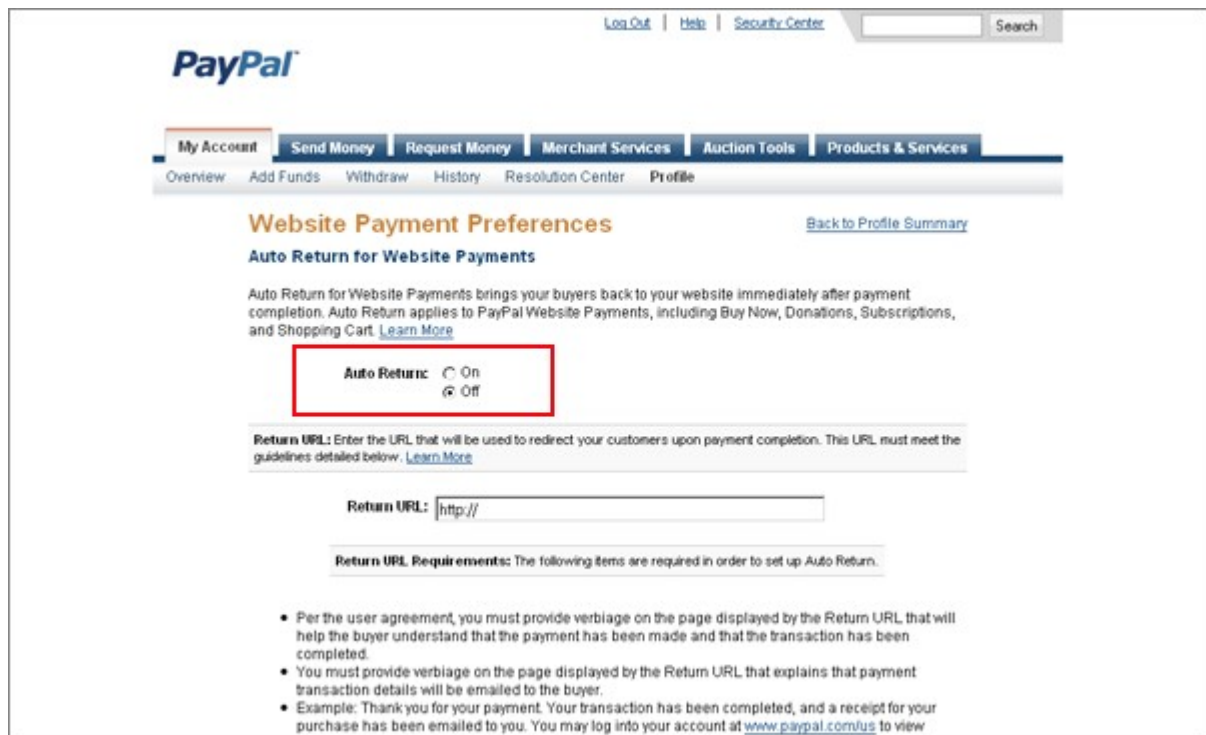

3. Within your PayPal account, go to My Account > Profile > Selling Preferences > Website Payment Preferences and make sure the following settings are at their default values:

- Auto return: Off
- Block Non-encrypted Website Payment: Off
- PayPal Account Optional: On

If you do have 'Auto return' set to 'On', then please set 'Payment Data Transfer' to 'On' as well.



E-junkie: Shopping cart or Buy Now buttons through Google Checkout

You may use [Google Checkout](#) Buy Now or Shopping cart buttons with E-junkie to enable your customers to pay using the Credit card associated with their Google Checkout account. You will receive payments into the bank account associated with your Google Checkout account. There is no setup and monthly fee for accepting payments through Google Checkout, the processing fee is 2% + \$0.20 per transaction.

1. [Sign up](#) for a Google Checkout merchant account.
2. Inside your Google Checkout account go to Settings > Integration.
 - Copy your Merchant ID and Merchant Key - you will need to enter them in your E-junkie profile.
 - Enter <https://www.E-junkie.com/gc/ResponseHandler.php> in the API callback URL field
 - Set the Callback method to XML
 - Press "Save Settings" button.
 - Select "Automatically authorize the buyer's credit card for the full amount of the order" under Order Processing Preferences.

3. Then in Settings > Preferences > Order Processing Preferences select "Automatically authorize the buyer's credit card for the full amount of the order"

4. Within your E-junkie account go to Seller Admin > Edit Profile > Selling with Google Checkout enter your Google Checkout Merchant Key and Merchant ID.

E-junkie: Shopping cart or Buy Now buttons through Authorize.net

Integration with [Authorize.Net](#) will let you accept Credit Card payments from Buy Now buttons or Shopping Cart directly into your online merchant account. The setup fee for the Authorize.Net account would depend on the selected reseller, the monthly fees would vary depending on the features enabled but typically be ~ \$20-30, the processing fee is 2.10% + \$0.25 per transaction.

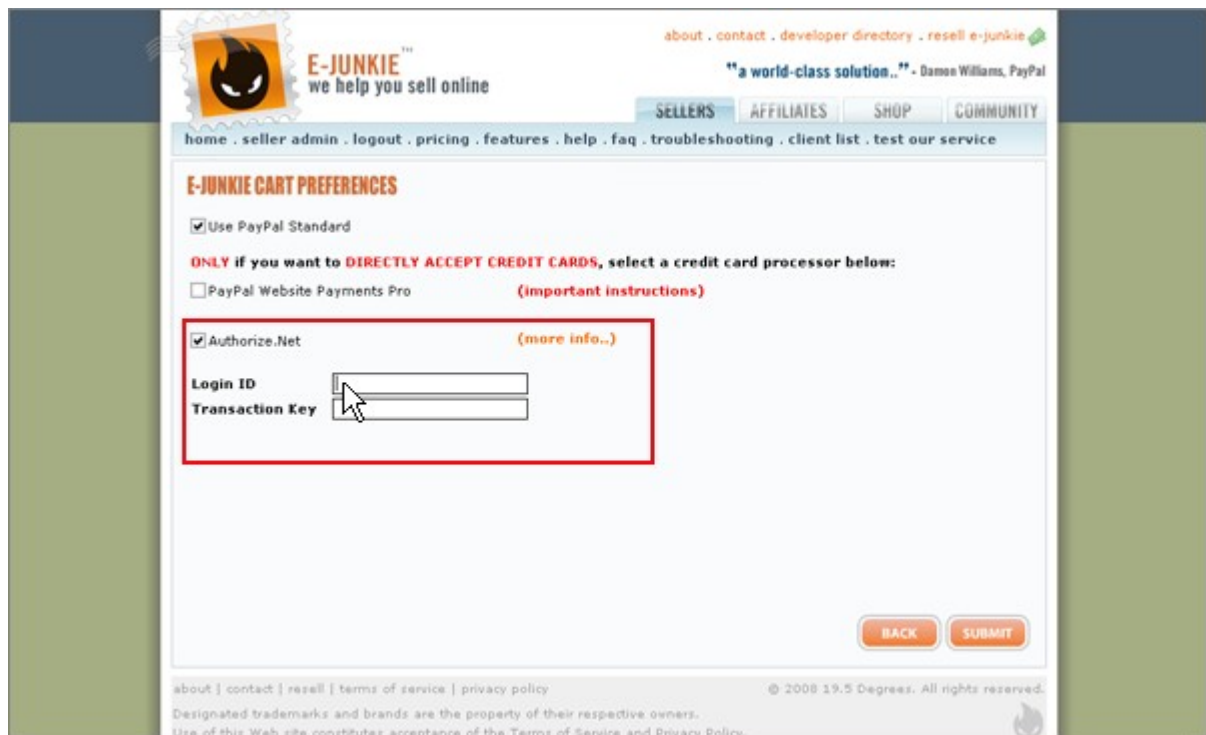
1. Log into your [Authorize.Net](#) account.
2. Go to Account > API Login ID and Transaction Key and copy the information inside.

E-junkie: Buy Now buttons through 2CheckOut or TrialPay

E-junkie offers integration with [2CheckOut](#) and [TrialPay](#) but only for Buy Now buttons, not Shopping cart. So, you may use these processors mainly for selling non-tangible items - i.e. digital product like ebooks, software, gift cards etc.

With 2CheckOut there is a \$49 setup fee, no monthly fee, and 5.5% commission plus a \$0.45 charge on each total sale.

With TrialPay you can offer your product for free and still earn the full cash value or more for your product when a customer purchases one of TrialPay advertisers' products. There is no subscription or processing fee.

The digital delivery of your product files will be automated and secure - with option to set download links to expire after set number of downloads or specified time period.

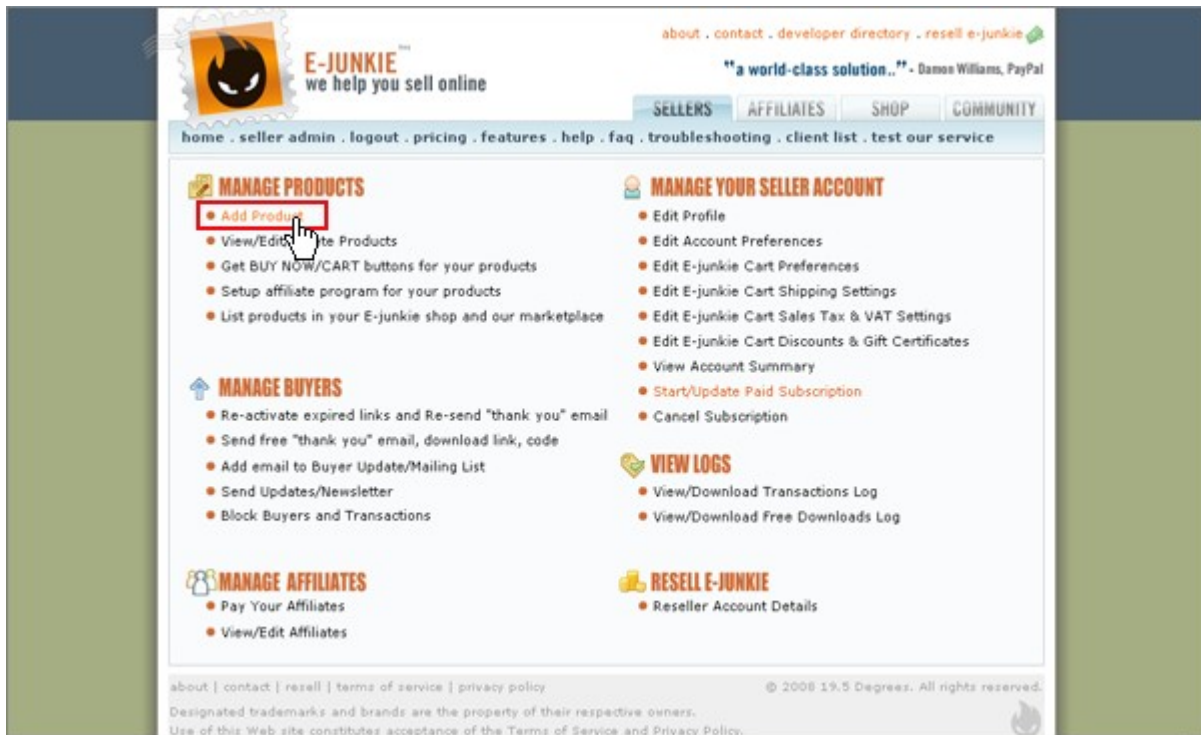

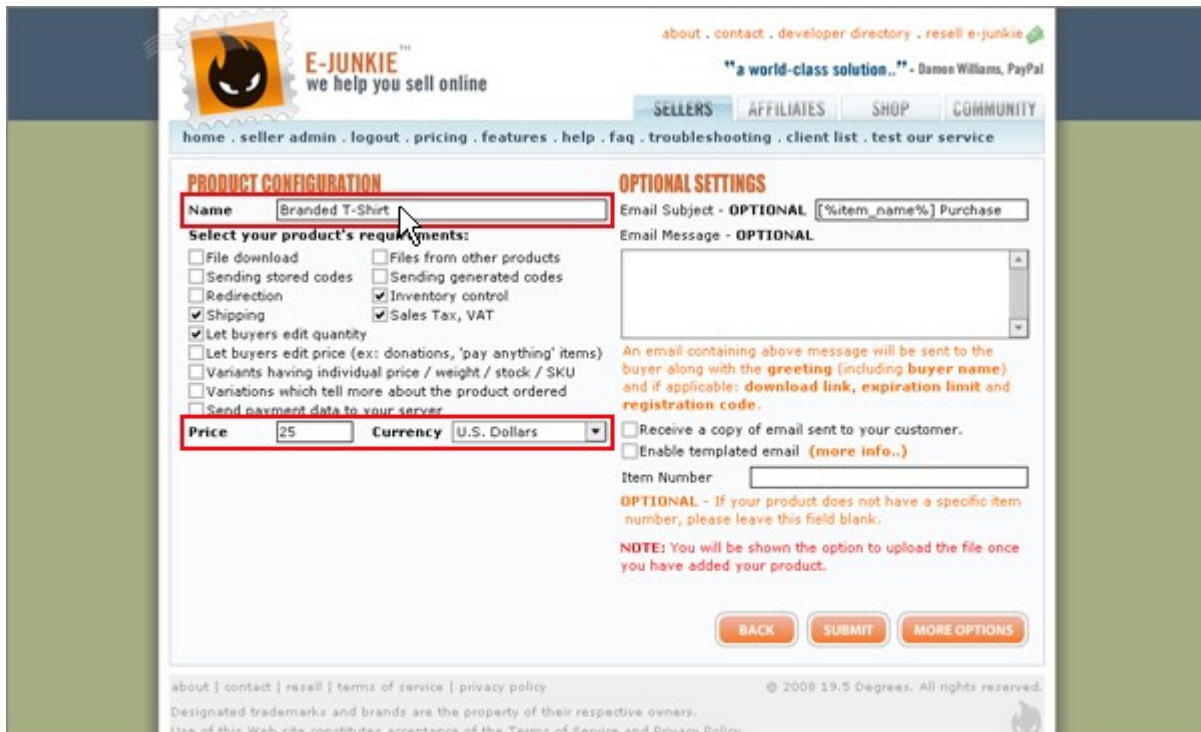
E-junkie: Add your products

Once you have configured your payment processors, you can proceed with adding your products.

1. Login to your E-junkie account and from Seller Admin > Manage Products click on "Add Product"



2. Specify Product Name, Price and Currency



3. Specify the Requirements for your product depending on its type and the expected result after purchase.

a) For a downloadable item - e.g. an electronic book - enable the option for **file download**. On next steps you will be prompted to upload your product files. The product would be delivered for download to your customer upon payment. ([see more on digital delivery](#))

b) For a product which requires activation with a code - e.g. a software registration code - select the option for **sending stored or generated codes**. ([see details on selling codes](#))

c) For a tangible item - e.g. Tshirts - enable **shipping** ([see help on the shipping and handling calculator](#)), **sales tax and VAT** ([see details on setting up sales tax and VAT](#)).

If the item allows for variations in which affect the price (e.g. color, size etc) enable the option for "Variants having individual price". ([see details on setting up variants](#))

If customers should be able to purchase multiple items from one product - select the option "Let buyers edit quantity".

For tangible goods you may also want to enable **inventory control**. ([see details on managing inventory](#))

d) If your are selling a service for which you need to simply redirect the buyer to a specific page on your site after the purchase, select the **redirection** option. ([see details on configuring redirection](#))

e) At present you can't use E-junkie for selling recurring subscriptions where your customer is automatically billed for the service on regular intervals (each month, year, etc). Consider adding [PayPal](#) or [2Checkout](#) buttons directly if you are selling recurring subscriptions.

4. The Optional settings would allow you to configure your "thank you" email to the buyer. ([see further details on customization](#)). You may leave these settings empty for a standard message.

5. Press **SUBMIT** button or use More Options to configure additional product settings (packaging for tangible items, expiration, valid number of downloads for digital items, discounts, or, if selling with 2Checkout, specify your 2Checkout Product ID)

6. The final page to which you will arrive after adding the product will give you the **Cart or Buy Now** button code you should place on your website. If your product is a downloadable file, on this page you will also have an Upload button to upload your product file.

a) If you are selling a single product you may use the **Buy Now buttons** code for integration within your site. Select this tab and click on your a payment processor to get the code for it. You may add buttons for multiple payment processors for one product.

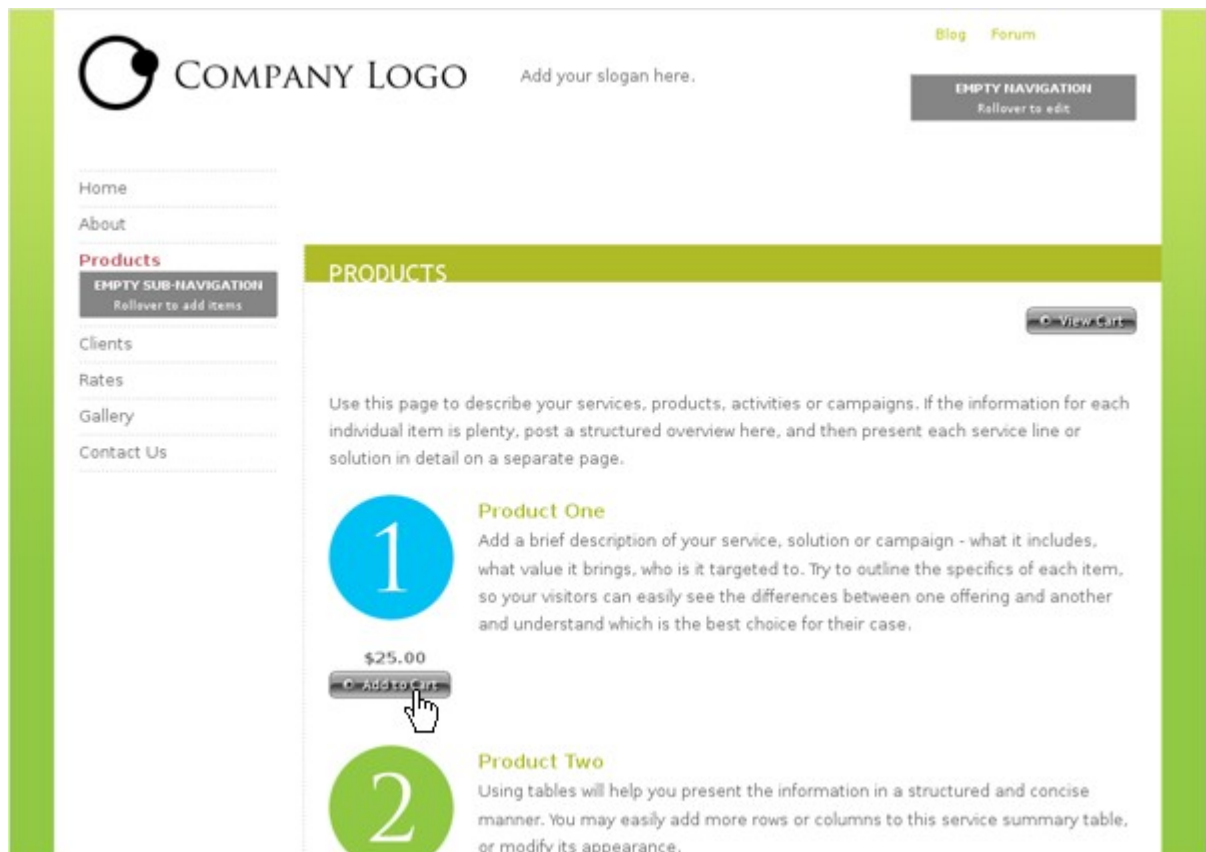

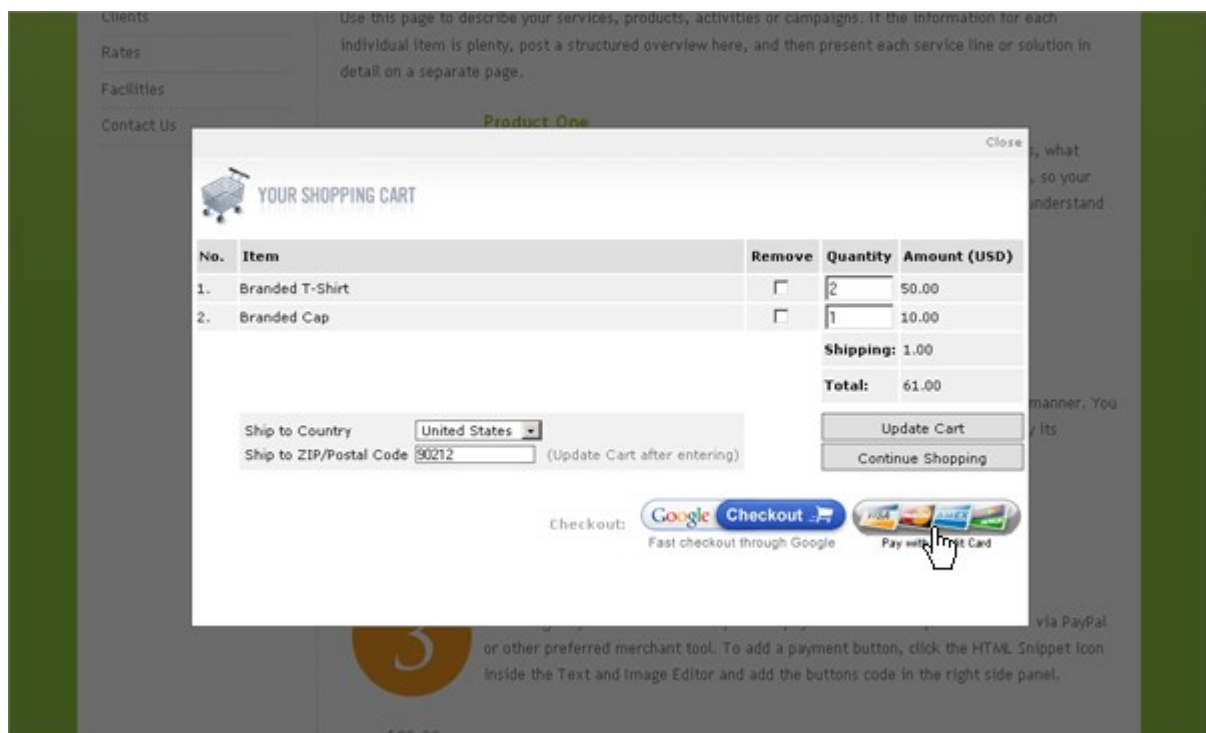

8. Publish your page and test-drive the setup.

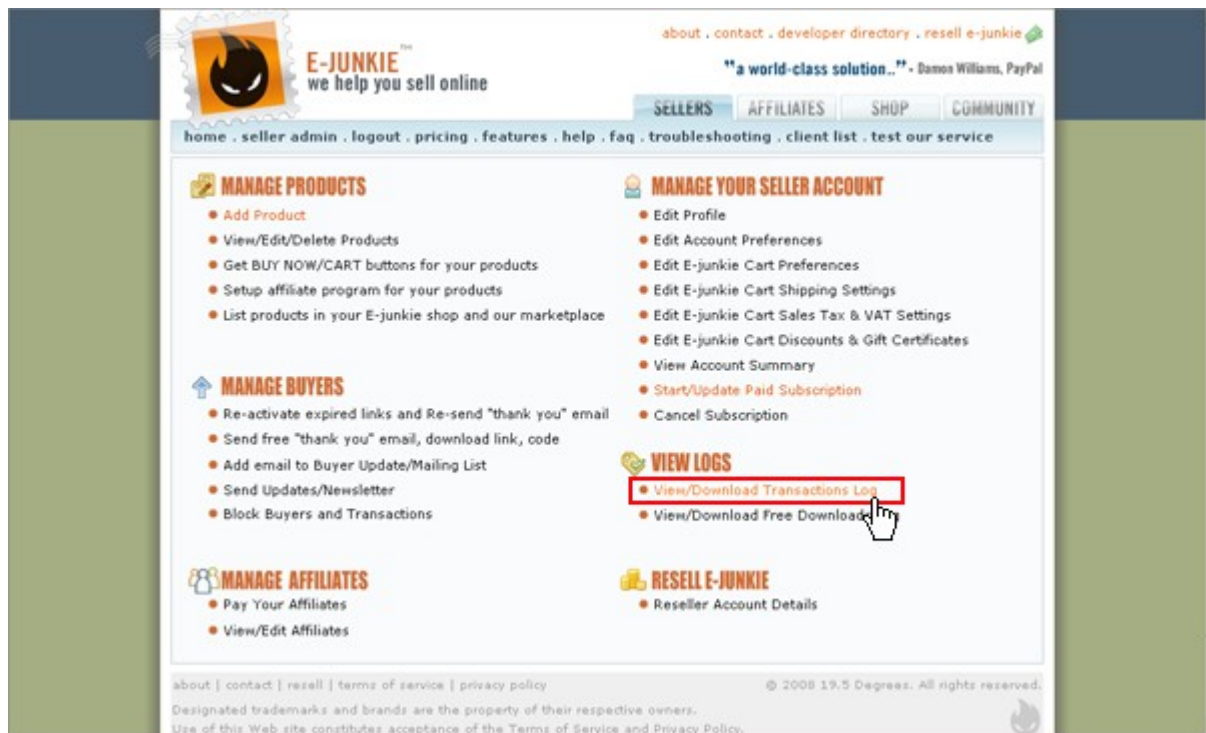


On clicking to order an item it will be added to the customer's shopping cart. On View Cart the customer will be able to see and edit all items in the cart, select a payment method depending on the payment processors you have enabled and proceed to checkout.



9. For each order you will receive a notification from your payment processor. You will also

receive an email with transaction info from E-junkie. You can view all transaction details from E-junkie Seller Admin > View Logs > View Downloads transaction logs.
