This report for the year 2008 reflects the statistics for activity generated by the public and by our personnel. While the overall trend indicates "serious crime" is down 16%, "general crime" and "calls for service" are up. Furthermore, traffic crashes have decreased 6% while traffic arrests and criminal arrests have increased, 5% and 7.5% respectively.

Statistics, however, do not tell the whole story of the department's mission. There are many facets of "law enforcement" that are "intangible". The department's "ideological identity" as described in our mission statement, is "to enhance the quality of life in our community ... by providing and maintaining a safe and secure environment." This is measured in more than merely keeping reported crime and arrest statistics. There are several functions the department provides that reinforces our dedication and service to the community.

For example, the DARE program has been a well-established program which exemplifies this principle of commitment to the community. The program has been highly successful, not only in saying "no to drugs", but also in bolstering self-esteem in our children to make the right choices in other areas of life. The DARE officer is also devoted as a School Resource Officer, one who provides preventative and counseling services.

The department now has a number of its officers trained as members of the Crisis Intervention Team (CIT). The training focuses on providing practical techniques for de-escalating crises. This training is highly specialized to provide police officers the skills needed to respond effectively to mental disturbance calls.

The department re-established a K-9 unit in 2008. This canine team, whose functions may include criminal apprehension, tracking, searches, officer protection, evidence recovery, narcotics detection and public demonstrations, will be invaluable in the support of patrol.

Even in the Detective Bureau statistics are not to be assessed too highly. Much of the detectives' work is time consuming and tedious, doing background and criminal history checks, legwork for outside agencies, following up on old and new cases, and of course, a great deal of report writing.

Another full time position which requires full time attention, and which receives little acclaim, is the department's drug task force officer. As a member of the Portage County Drug Task Force, the police department is committed to aggressively combating illegal drug activity within the City, as well as county-wide.

Once again, budgetary concerns must be addressed for the coming year. The basic capital outlay for 2008 was only for vehicle replacements. Two cruisers and two much needed unmarked cars were purchased. It is imperative the agency now continues with the rotation of three cruisers a year, which, with nine cruisers, would cycle each every three years.

Projected capital improvements for the coming year include a new phone system, cruiser camera upgrades, and replacement of in-house computers. These needs, along with other essential equipment, may be contingent upon the passage of the proposed tax credit issue

in 2009.

Furthermore, an increase in manpower is essential to maintain peace and security in providing a professional police service to all. Our personnel dedicate themselves to improving the quality of life in the City by maintaining a safe and secure environment. Our plan in 2009 is to increase patrol officers by obtaining a grant from the COPS Hiring Recovery Program. This will provide 100 percent funding for three years to hire additional officers under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

Members of the police department appreciate the cooperation and support you have offered. We thank you for recognizing our needs so that we can provide the highest level of professional law enforcement our community deserves. 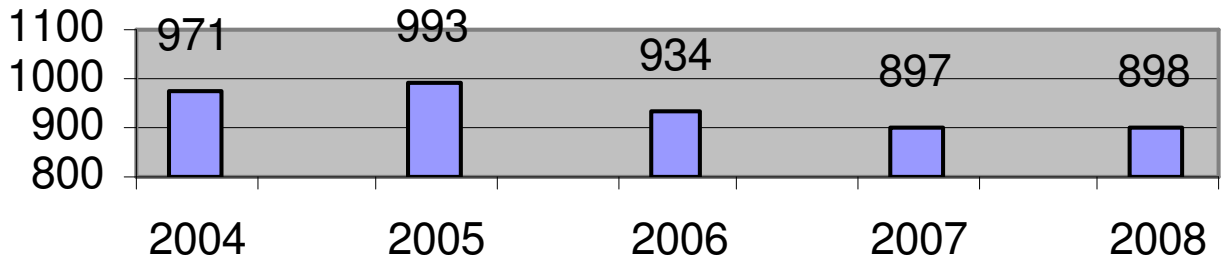

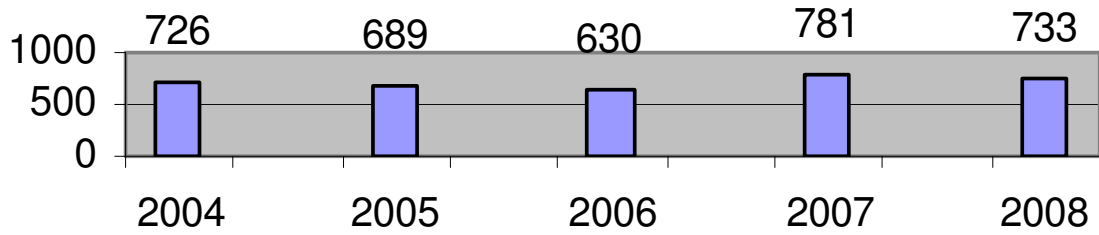

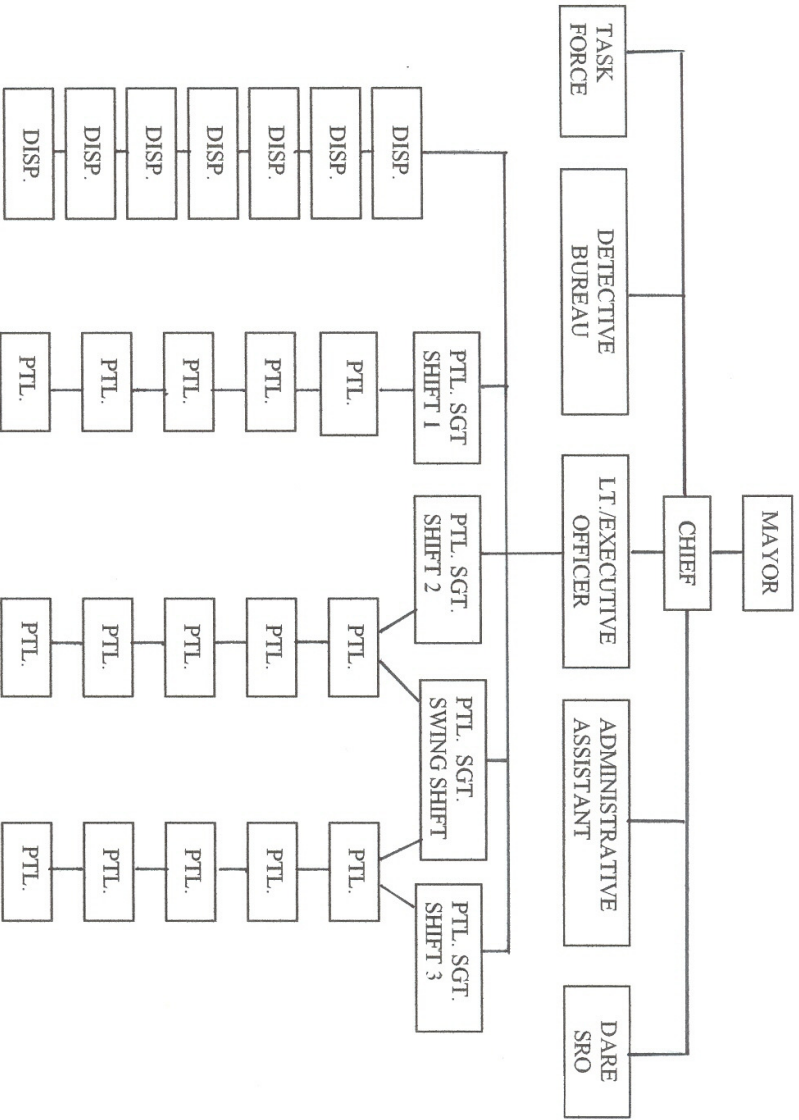
