## INTRODUCING “HONORING THE GAME” TO YOUR TEAM

At the start of the season, let your players know you want to coach a team that Honors the Game. Honoring the Game means that your team will have respect for the ROOTS of the game:

- **Rules** – We refuse to bend/break the rules to win.
- **Opponents** – We value and recognize that a worthy opponent brings out our best, and we take a “fierce and friendly” attitude into competition.
- **Officials** – We respect all officials even when we disagree with them.
- **Teammates** – We never do anything to embarrass our team (on or off the field).
- **Self** – We live up to our standards of Honoring the Game, even when others don’t.
