Some of the things included the installation of new WYTJ signs in the area. In September we assisted another radio station is setting up their radio programming. Did you realize the word broadcast is used to describe the act of sowing seed? We see Jesus in Luke 8:6-15 teaching the parable of sowing seed, the Word of God. Broadcasting simply means to cast or scatter seed in all directions. WYTJ broadcasts, or makes public the Word of God in all directions. Wow! How wonderful to know you are part of that. Our goal is to give folks in Greene County and beyond an opportunity to hear the life-changing message of the Gospel.

In order to reach new listeners we had some 4'x8' signs designed and placed at various locations in the county. The first sign we installed was just east of the entrance to Shakamak State Park. The call letters have a blue reflective tape that appears to light up as you drive past. A second sign was installed next to Ross's Floor store located at the junction of Highway 54 and 59. A third sign was installed on County Road 700 across from Providence Baptist Church. The cost of each sign is around \$400. If you would like more information about sponsoring a sign or have a high traffic area at which we could put a sign, feel free to contact us.



In August we experienced a little problem with our main antenna and transmitter. It took a couple weeks to get everything back up to speed. A special thanks to Frank who volunteered his time and skill to climb the 180' tower to locate and replace several damaged parts.

In September our program director was able to assist WGV West Virginia Gospel Voice setting up their radio program templates. They are now broadcasting many of the same programs and music you hear on WYTJ in West Union, WV.



A very special thanks to the family who made the 24' cross and donated the amazing sign that reads "Home of Christian Radio WYTJ 89.3 FM Will You Trust Jesus". Both of these are located in front of the church.

Fall Share-A-Thon October 25-29, 2011 from 7am-7pm

Their will be a 1st ever National Emergency Action Network test conducted on November 9, 2011 at 2:00p.m.. This is a mandatory test of the EAS Emergency Alert System for all television and radio stations. The test will be conducted by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The test will start at approximately 2 p.m. (Eastern Standard Time) and may last up to three and a half minutes. This test will help determine the reliability of the Emergency Alert System. This same test will then be conducted every year but on different dates.
