Beautifully integrated French oak provides the structure for this wine which is aging gracefully. One of New Zealand's most outstanding Cabernet dominant wines.

Willows Bonesetter Shiraz 2004 Barossa Valley

\$119

One of the finest producers of Shiraz in the Barossa Valley. This is the premium Shiraz from Willows and is produced from vines planted in the early 1960s. Peter Scholz is the 6th generation to produce wines under the Willows label and has developed the Bonesetter lable in memory of JG Scholz, who in an earlier career set broken bones in the Prussian army. This a truly outstanding wine with great depth and persistence on the palate, rich blackberry and plum fruit with silky tannins on the finish. 96/100 James Halliday
