Abortion on Demand

Bill Bolling opposes abortion and supports protection for unborn children. Bolling had a 100% pro-life voting record as a Virginia state senator.

Jody Wagner supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

As Lieutenant Governor, **Bill Bolling** cast the decisive vote that would have banned taxpayer funding for Planned Parenthood, which operates the largest chain of abortion facilities in the U.S.

Abortion on Demand

Ken Cuccinelli opposes abortion and supports protection for unborn children. State Senator Cuccinelli has a 100% pro-life rating from Virginia Society for Human Life.

Steve Shannon supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason. State Delegate Shannon has a 100% pro-abortion rating since 2005 from NARAL Pro-Choice Virginia.

Ultrasound Legislation

Ken Cuccinelli supports legislation to offer women the opportunity to see an ultrasound of their baby prior to an abortion.

Steve Shannon voted against offering women the opportunity to see an ultrasound of their baby prior to an abortion. (2009, HB 2579)

Coerced/Forced Abortions

Ken Cuccinelli supports legislation to protect women from being forced to have an abortion.

Steve Shannon voted against legislation that would have protected women from being forced to have an abortion. (2007, HB 1665)
