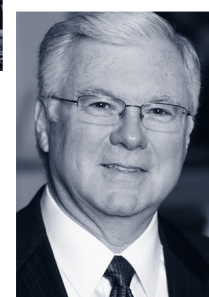

I just left a banquet for a ministry called First Choice (formerly known as Sav-A-Life). The emotions and thoughts that ran through my head and heart are hard to fully process. So much so, that though I'm really tired, I simply cannot allow these thoughts to sail off into the night unexpressed.

They are a nonprofit organization that provides education, alternatives, counseling, and more for women who are considering or have already had an abortion. The more I learn about the issue of abortion, and the more I hear about these alternative crisis pregnancy centers, the more my heart burns to ACT.



The reason is because ... I'm an abortion survivor myself. I have never said this publicly either verbally or in written form (to a broad audience) until now. Now please don't misunderstand me. My mom means the world to me. Thinking through my life... it's hard to figure out where she ends and I begin. She inspires me to go

on!!! She modeled what it meant to persevere in faith for many years in my home. However, she revealed to me only 4 years ago, that twice during her pregnancy with me she tried to abort me in pretty dramatic fashion. Once she drank a deadly toxin that was supposed to make her have an abortion. When that failed, she actually JUMPED OFF THE ROOF OF A BUILDING AND ROLLED ON HER STOMACH hoping that would terminate my little life growing in her womb.

Shortly after that she was in church (the church I eventually grew up in) and the pastor preached a sermon on the Old Testament story of Hannah's Prayer for a child. It was at that time she gave her life to God; committed to having me; and she also dedicated me to God like Hannah dedicated Samuel to the Lord. To this day, she often says how she is constantly blown away by the things God has done in and through my life. Of course she regrets her actions, but God used it to draw her to Himself. He has heard that prayer prayed 30 years ago and answered it in extraordinary ways.

When I consider God's word concerning the unborn- the life God has graciously allowed me to live... my 3 girls... my wife... and the lives the Lord has graciously chosen to use me to impact for His Kingdom... I CAN'T HELP BUT HATE ABORTION. What if one of those attempts would have worked?
