SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY

JANUARY 22, 2012

Since 1983, Americans have observed Sanctity of Human Life Sunday as a day to observe the intrinsic value of all human life. Sanctity of Human Life Sunday is held on the Sunday in January that falls closest to the day Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton decisions were handed down by the U.S. Supreme Court on January 22, 1973. First Choice Women's Medical Center considers this day to be a special opportunity to share life and light instead of death and darkness. At First Choice, we are committed to bringing the message of the love and life of Jesus to the parents and their unborn children.

ABORTIONS IN THE UNITED STATES STATS FROM GUTTMACHER INSTITUTE

- 1 out of 3 women has an abortion by the age of 45.
- Abortions happen to women from all walks of life.
- 58% are in their 20's.
- 2 in 10 girls that have an abortion are in their teens. Of those teens the ones having an abortion are 18 & 19 years old.
- 6 in 10 already have a child.
- 3 out of 4 say they have a religious affiliation.
- 36% are white
- 30% African Americans
- 25% Hispanics
- 9% other
- Women of color are disproportionately likely to have an abortion. They have a higher rate of unintended pregnancy.

CELEBRATING 30 YEARS OF SERVICE TO MONTGOMERY

A TIME LINE OF HISTORY

1982

- An agreement was signed between Wales Goebel Ministry, Inc. and the Montgomery Fellowship, Inc. to use the name Sav-A-Life, Montgomery, Inc. Incorporated as a 501 (c) 3
 - Began operation in a small, rented office on Carmichael Parkway
 - Open 5 days a week
-

1987

- Building at 1620 Mulberry Street was donated to Sav-A-Life. The building was renovated with volunteer efforts.
 - The Mulberry office opened in December. Closed the office on Carmichael Parkway.
-

1989

- Began ministry to post abortive women
-

1990

- Began program of sequential visits for first time pregnant clients, subsequently named Life Choices.
-

1995

- Leased small space in Carol Villa to serve as a part time satellite office, while continuing full time operation at Mulberry Street. The intent was to confirm the need for services in East Montgomery.
-

1997

- Purchased building at Mendel Parkway. Renovated with primarily volunteer labor.
 - Began full time operation at Mendel Parkway in November, while maintaining full time operation at Mulberry. Moved out of Carol Villa.
 - Moved administrative offices from Mulberry Street.
-

1999

- Began Insights and Options abstinence program for single clients.

2003

- Began evening hours, continuing full time day time hours at both centers.
-

2004

- Launched purity program, using God Made You Unique, for churches and schools which would allow a Christian perspective.
-

2005

- Sav-A-Life became affiliated with CareNet, a national network of approximately 700 centers.
-

2006

- A Medical Director and a Nurse Manager were added to the staff to become a medical center.
-

2007

- Closed Mulberry office and moved all operations to Mendel Parkway.
 - Began First Choice Women's Medical Center. Stopped Insights and Options and Life Choices. Began limited obstetrical ultrasounds.
-

2008

- Marjory McCarty retired in January and Susan Decker Bunce began as Executive Director.
 - Began the Baby Bottle Boomerang project.
-

2009

- Began a new program called Psalms 139 for women that continue to make poor choices.
-

2010

- Began Men's Ministry with Jay Joye.
 - Licensed by the Alabama State Board of Health as an Independent Physiological Laboratory.
-

2011

- Renovated the Mendel facility to place a rest room between the ultrasound exam rooms for the patients.
