RE: K-9 Drug Sweep of Streetsboro High School

On Thursday April 30th at 9:15am, K-9 teams from Streetsboro PD, Windham PD, Ohio Dept. of Natural Resources, Brimfield Twp. PD, Brooklyn PD, Rocky River PD, East Cleveland PD, Lorain County Metro Parks PD, Olmsted Falls PD, and Brunswick Hills PD conducted a K-9 narcotics sweep of Streetsboro High School. The interior of the high school, as well as vehicles in the parking lot areas were checked by the K-9 teams after the school administration placed the building into lockdown.

All of the participating departments, including Streetsboro PD, are part of B.A.R.K (Buckeye Area Regional K-9). Today was a planned training day for the group, therefore all participated in aiding with the sweep.

Several lockers inside the school were hit on, as well as eleven (11) vehicles in the parking lot area. Some marijuana residue was located in two of the vehicles, and beer was present in another vehicle. All three students are facing administrative sanctions from the high school. Two other students were found to have prohibited items in their lockers, one with tobacco products and another with household cleaning chemicals. They face administrative sanctions from the school system as well. Refer to Streetsboro High School regarding any suspensions.

This sweep was conducted in cooperation with Streetsboro school administration. The sweep of the building and parking lot area concluded at approximately 10:45am.

At this time, no formal criminal charges have been filed as a result of the sweep.
