Our goal at NBT is point you to Christ and the power of the Gospel so that you may live a life that glorifies the Lord.

It is impossible to explain every aspect of being an NBT Evangelist in one brochure. The following are four of the key areas why you should consider traveling with Neighborhood Bible Time this summer.

I. The preaching of God's Word is preeminent.

IV. You will see God provide for you over the summer.


You must depend on the Lord to provide financially, physically, and spiritually, so you will learn to depend on Him as never before.
