

Uniform Information

Two checks are needed for uniforms and accessories.

For uniform rental, check goes to: **Prattville High School \$75**

For accessories and fair share, check goes to: **PRATTVILLE BAND BOOSTERS**

Checklist for band students.

1. Percussion/Pit – all accessories except no sash, and no gloves
2. Tuba- all accessories except they receive a tuba hat instead of the Shako Hat

Student must supply:

_____ Black socks (not too thick), they need to fit comfortably
_____ Black shorts- Inseam must be longer than 2 inches, elastic waist; pull on shorts. Shorts must be totally black. Try to get shorts with no logo. A very small logo (i.e. swish) may pass inspection. (Try Wal-Mart, Hibbett's Sports, & Kmart). The girls may wear Softe black shorts found at Belks and Sports Authority.

*Shoes are prepaid and will be ordered during band camp.

The red shirt and black shorts are worn under the uniform. Many times, the students will wear the red shirt and black shorts to performances and then put on their band uniform before "show time".

Band students are responsible for their uniform and accessories. When you leave the buses or stadium; you must be sure you have everything including your instrument. Any items left on the bus/stadium will be turned into to Mr. Cothran.

Hems

1. The band member is responsible for any hemming. Pants must be hemmed, not just safety pin in place.
2. Hems are to be hand sewn or professional done.
3. **DO NOT CUT OFF** any of the hem.
4. **DO NOT USE FUSIBLE WEBBING**
5. Commercial seamstresses in town are Patti's (downtown) and Tang's (near Burger King).

Dry Cleaning

1. Dry cleaning is the band member's responsibility.
2. Uniforms needs to be dry-cleaned after performing in hot or rainy weather and before final turn in.
3. **If uniform becomes wet, the uniform must be hung up and air-dried. DO NOT LEAVE IT IN THE BAG.**
4. Hats need to be taken out of the box to air-dry, regularly.
5. Plumes do not go home, they are removed by parent volunteers and placed in special containers.

It is the band members' responsibility for repairs to be made to the uniform.
