Bruce believes strongly in the power of the written word to convey truth and move people into God's will for them. He has written more than 60 books that have been translated into 30 languages, including several

books that reached the number-one spot on the bestseller lists of the *New York Times*, the *Wall Street Journal*, and *USA Today*. Bruce's breakout book, *The Prayer of Jabez*, remains the fastest selling book in history, with worldwide sales exceeding 20 million. *The Prayer of Jabez* was also the first book to win the Christian Book of the Year award two years in a row. Meanwhile, Bruce's *A Life God Rewards* became the first religious nonfiction book to appear at the number-one spot on the *New York Times* bestseller list in its first week on the market. His other popular books include *The Secrets of the Vine*, *Beyond Jabez*, *Set Apart*, *Experiencing Spiritual Breakthroughs*, *The Dream Giver*,

Being a part of this ministry has been such a blessing to me. For years I felt the Holy Spirit tugging at my heart strings to allow the Lord to use me. Going through training, however, caused me to question my ability to do the job I felt called to do. I felt inadequate and totally overwhelmed! Now I'm quite sure that Satan had his hand in that—isn't that just like him?

Now that I'm about to start my ninth year, I can't imagine not working my shift every week. Belinda Daugherty, my partner and I, along with a staff member have a sweet time of prayer before our shift begins. Through the years, we've grown close to each other and closer to the Lord. We're ready for whatever may come our way when we leave our prayer time!

Having a one-on-one experience with our women provides time for us to assess them as we ask questions on the intake sheet, learn something about their fears, concerns, etc. before the nurse comes in with their results. It also provides a time to talk with them about a relationship with God. Some have open hearts to the gospel and are led to professing Christ or rededicating their lives to the Lord. Others are not easily swayed and turn a deaf ear. Many times that's because they've not ever been exposed to the Truth. Therein lies a challenge for us, but we operate on the premise that we can only plant the seeds. If a patient needs time with us for more explanation and soul searching, we give them more time.

Some women are abortion minded and not willing to give an inch until they have an ultrasound. What a fantastic tool that machine is for our ministry. Seeing their baby for the first time usually brings on the tears and we can see their hard heart and hard nosed determination melt into sweet submission to God's will for that baby.

Lest I forget, I must salute our nurses who are the best yet! Their time with our women is priceless. We have developed camaraderie with them and sometimes we cooperatively bring a woman to the Lord. How God has blessed us with godly nurses who love the Lord and our patients. To God be the glory!

The house on South Perry Street beside the only abortion clinic in Montgomery is available for Rent.

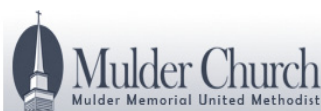
